We call it 360 because the Leadership Day is six hours long or three hundred and sixty minutes of inspiration, training, and meaningful fellowship. It is a one-day conference designed to equip and inspire everyone who serves in the local church from a new volunteer to a full-time pastor.

The 2026 theme is “**ONE MORE In Jesus Name**” with the primary scripture coming from the words of Jesus in the Great Commission (Matthew 28:19-20). We pray for **ONE MORE** disciple committing to living like Jesus, **ONE MORE** leader serving and making disciples, and **ONE MORE** church renewed in the mission of showing its community who Jesus is. At 360, the Leadership Development Team provides opportunities for you to grow as a disciple of Jesus and as a leader serving Jesus. This year, let’s pray for ONE MORE in Jesus Name.

For today, 360 brings us together to be challenged in our understanding and our ministries. Come and find some tips on managing the dollars available to you each month, tackling debt, planning for a comfortable financial future, how to lose money quickly, and how to make money without working!

Church of God Theology

This track will focus on unique aspects of Church of God Theology, why we believe them and how to defend that belief. **Presenters** *Nick Wilson Sr Pastor Kittaning, and Zachary Lays Sr Pastor New Bethlehem*

- **What do you mean when you Say God?** Sometimes, when we talk with others, the biggest disconnect lies in what we mean when we use a word. This presentation will offer a brief discussion of God and how different understandings of the word “God” can lead to very different conclusions. Join us as we explore a few of the ways that historical, biblical orthodoxy has understood and used the word “God”.
- **What does it mean to be Human?** As the Church seeks to address issues of deep theological significance, we must look to and understand the foundational realities of existence. This presentation will offer a brief survey of Christian Anthropology. Join us as we delve into what it means to be human and explore how the Bible’s answer to that question can frame many of the difficult issues of our day.
